FAQs

What happens if I tick the box to increase my giving in line with inflation?

As you approach the anniversary of your gift, you will receive communication from PGS detailing what the inflation linked gift amount will be for the coming year. If for any reason you do not wish to for that increase to be actioned, simply notify PGS.

What do I do about my existing gift?

You may wish to wait until you receive confirmation of your new giving arrangements from PGS before cancelling any current Standing Orders.

Does it cost the church anything?

PGS is a free service for churches and givers. St David's will receive 100% of all <u>regular gifts</u> and Gift Aid.

Sometimes I top up my giving with a one off gift, can I still do this?

One off gifts can now be made through PGS online, using all major credit and debit cards as well as Apple and Google Pay. We incur a small 1.5% transaction fee on these gifts, however, if you are able to Gift Aid, PGS will claim this on our behalf too.


Support your church by joining the Parish Giving Scheme



What is the Parish Giving Scheme?

The Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is a national charity and not for profit organisation which makes possible regular, planned giving through the use of Direct Debit, and assists with administration such as claiming our Gift Aid each month from HMRC.

It is trusted by nearly 78,000 church members nationally, across over 30 member dioceses. In Birmingham, there are over 70 registered communities with more than 1200 givers using the scheme to make their financial offerings to their church.



We are confident that PGS is of value both to those who give generously in support of our church and to those we trust with the financial management of St David's.

How does PGS work?


PGS is safe, secure, and simple to use, and you stay in control of your giving, always. The PGS is a registered UK charity.

First, you join PGS in one of the three easy ways described in this leaflet. Then your gift is given by Direct Debit monthly, quarterly or annually, as you choose.

Leaving your account on the first of the month, PGS helps us offer our first fruits to God, *(Deut 26:1-4)* and makes giving easy and efficient.

You can also Gift Aid your giving if applicable and this is automatically claimed from HMRC, helping cash flow and saving time. The Gift Aid is in our church bank account the same month as your gift.
